1. **San Perito Sauvignon-Semillon, Central Valley, Chile**
Full and ripe with an enticing broad, tropical style and peachy, floral flavours all held together with a creamy weight and bright, zippy raciness. (2) 12.5%vol

2. **Santa Helena Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile**
A classic New World Chardonnay - ripe but not blowsy, rich but not oaked, full-bodied but not overweight. It shows lots of ripe tropical fruit freshness with floral undertones and a bright, clean finish. (2) 13%vol

3. **Avanti Chenin-Torrontes, Bodegas Borbore San Juan, Argentina**

Light, jammy, easy-drinking red. The cassis fruit style of Cabernet softened up with the gentle roundness of Merlot. (B) 13.5%vol

11. **Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine, Chereau Carré, France**
Dry, crisp, and fresh with a sea-breeze and light almond character. Carries a light and easy natural style. (1) 12%vol

White-and-green, fresh and grassy, quite sweet and well balanced with some edge. Clean pure style. (4) 8.5%vol

This innovative family firm produces their modern dry Rosé in a bright fruity style that is positively full-flavoured and almost serious. Vivid redcurrant fruit drives a super-fresh experience. (2) 13%vol

20. **Benchmark Shiraz, Grant Burge, South Australia**
Rich aromas of pepper, dark berries and spice. On the palate there are layers of oak, fruit and savoury spice with a smooth finish as long as a tiger's tail. (D) 14.5%vol

21. **Cabernet Sauvignon, Domaine de Montaubéron Côtes de Thongue, France**
Full of plummy, generous fruit with varietal character notes of cassis and currant. Solid rich weight with a grippy style reflective of its location. (C) 13%vol

22. **Merlot, Laroche, Languedoc, France**
Real purple. Rich Merlot smell. Velvet-textured fruit flavours and a splash of oak to firm the taste and shape the finish. Absolutely textbook. (C) 13.5%vol

23. **Ermita de San Felices Tinto, Santiago Ijalba, Rioja, Spain**
Light and elegant with plenty of summer-pudding red berry fruit. It has a light oak influence that adds weight and concentration. The vibrant violet, cherry fruit is absolutely typical of good Tempranillo Rioja. (C) 12.5%vol

24. **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Zero, Collefrisio, Italy**
Wonderfully rich and concentrated with a lustrous purple black colour that intimates the fruit to come. It is an astonishingly intense wine with masses of ripe black fruit; tarry, hedgerow complexity and a touch of chocolate to round it out. Exceptional stuff. (C) 13.5%vol

25. **Pinotage By L'Avenir, Laroche, Western Cape, South Africa**
Full of red berry fruit and a hint of spice, but subtly overlaid with the typically pinotage smoky gamey qualities that make it so individual. Brilliant with red meat. (D) 13.5%vol

26. **Devil's Corner Pinot Noir, Tamar Ridge, Tasmania**
This is no shrinking violet Pinot Noir. It is full of cinnamon spice and cherry fruit with attractive burnt-toffee notes. It is silky smooth with elegant fine tannins to bring out the berry fruits. One of the neatest and most elegant Pinots we have found Down Under for years. (B) 14%vol
